

**WEST BLOOMFIELD TOWN BOARD
REGULAR MEETING & PUBLIC HEARING**

July 12, 2006

Supervisor Champlin opened the meeting at 7:00 pm and asked everyone to stand for the Pledge of Allegiance.

RESOLUTION #62

Local Law #1-2006, Local Law to Amend the West Bloomfield Town Code

Supervisor Champlin opened the Public Hearing on Local Law #1-2006, “Local Law Amending the Code of the Town of West Bloomfield” and asked if anyone wished to speak.

Jim Foote of 2644 County Road 37 pointed out that he is in favor of all of the changes, but there might be a typo in Section 3D. The word building should be buildings. The Board agreed and the correction was approved.

Supervisor Champlin asked again if anyone wished to speak.

Alice Domville of 8901 Routes 5 & 20 asked if Section 4 would apply to the Williams property on 5 & 20.

Supervisor Champlin explained that the purpose of Section 4 would not affect the property.

Supervisor Champlin asked if anyone else wished to speak. Hearing no comments, he closed the Public Hearing at 7:12.
