RESOLUTION #81

Minutes

Supervisor Champlin asked for the approval of the August minutes. Councilman Powers requested a change to the August 9th minutes, changing the term “position of systems administrator” to “work of systems administrator”.

Superintendent Good presented the Highway Report and advised the Board that the living snow fence is doing very well. Roadwork, mowing and ditching are continuing. The lot near the park was leveled for a baseball field, NIMMS training for employees is done. The new tractor, damaged in transport, has not been repaired yet, payment is being held until resolved. Superintendent Good also reported that the water meter readings for September are done. The telephone system at the pump house is still not working well but he has spoken to Frontier, and that he is looking for a possible leak in the main. Councilman Powers made the motion to accept the Highway report, seconded by Councilman Rehberg.

RESOLUTION #86

Frontier Phone Bills – The Clerk presented the Board with a proposal for a phone system for town employees, updating phones and services and lowering the cost. The Board asked for references from places using the system, the Clerk will provide them at the workshop.

Old Business:

Factors Walk – Road Dedication - Supervisor Champlin advised the Board that Attorney Anderson confirmed Mr. Barnes does not want to go through with early dedication of the road and a letter was sent to the Honeoye Falls Lima School to see if the bus would use a privately owned road before proceeding with a plowing agreement with Mr. Barnes.

Budget Review – The 2007 budget was discussed, further discussion is scheduled for the workshop.

Elton Road Request for Weight Limit – A letter from Bill and Patty Guli, requesting a weight limit on Elton Road was discussed. Highway Superintendent Good reported that he has tried to verify trucks using the road and has seen none, and that in checking with local businesses, has been told they are not using Elton Road. A response to Mr. And Mrs. Guli will be written asking them if they can identify the vehicles, dates and times of the trucks using the road.

Summer Recreation Program -Councilman Ball reported that the program went very well and that all of the final reports are done.

Welcome to West Bloomfield – Supervisor Champlin advised the Board that he had been approached about the creation of a Welcome Wagon type of group for West Bloomfield. The Board was in favor of the idea, and Supervisor Champlin will get more information.

Councilman Hagen made the motion to adjourn at 8:26, seconded by Councilman Ball.
