Councilman Hagen made the motion to support keeping the beds at the VA Medical Center, seconded by Councilman Ball.

Resolves that the West Bloomfield Town Board unanimously supports Resolution #672-2006, adopted by the Ontario County Board of Supervisors, opposing the removal of Acute psychiatric beds at the Canandaigua Veterans Administration Hospital and will forward this resolution to all of our Federal Representatives to encourage them to carry our message of opposition to the Secretary of Veterans Affairs.

RV Law – The Board discussed the draft of an RV Law. Councilman Hagen will submit a new draft for the Board to review.

The Summer recreation program was discussed, and will be on the agenda for the Workshop.

Councilman Hagen made the motion to adjourn at 8:05, seconded by Councilman Powers.
