

## West Bloomfield Planning Board Meeting

March 18, 2009

**7:30PM** – Chrmn. Campbell called the meeting to order and noted there were no Public Hearings scheduled for this month.

**Dolomite/Route 64 Mine:** Chrmn. Campbell noted there were no specific questions regarding the Mine and that we had forwarded the maps to our Town Engineer for review. Tim would be contacting Scott to set up an inspection date. John Siel spoke and advised the Board they had already started the reclamation process. He showed them where on the maps and stated they only had 1-2 years mining left of “good” product. Also, the berm was already up and laddered. He pointed out where they would be mining this year and noted that, after the mining was done, they would be draining the ponds and filling them in. He advised the Board they have already started working with Pooler Enterprises for ideas on developing the land for future use. He gave a few examples of other properties they have reclaimed and what they are now being used for (Allens Creek project in Penfield). Alan Brind asked where the ponds drained and John stated they were self-contained. There were no further questions or comments and Chrmn. Campbell advised the clerk to schedule the Public Hearing for renewing their Special Use Permit for the April 15<sup>th</sup> meeting.

**February Minutes:** David Crystal made a motion to approve the minutes as submitted. Brad Lins seconded the motion, with ayes by all, and motion carried. [Minutes Approved.](#)

**Rochester Academy of Science:** Bob McGovern was not present to discuss this matter tonight. Chrmn. Campbell noted he was going to send an email to David Anderson for advice on how this application should be handled. He wasn't sure if the Planning Board should amend or modify the (RAS) Special Use Permit. Was Site Plan approval required? Was a Building Permit required? Planning Board referral? Scott will call Bob McGovern after we hear back from the Town Attorney.

**Parcel Line Adjustments/Combinations:** Clerk to email Kris Hughes to ask if we could have someone from the County Planning Department come to our April 1<sup>st</sup> meeting to discuss this matter.

**Parrish Mine:** David Crystal asked about the status of the Parrish/Olmstead Mine on Baker Road and noted there was some erosion. Clerk to check with DEC.
