RESOLUTION #87

Public Hearing on Local Law #2-2009 “Abolishment of Elected Assessor”

Supervisor Champlin opened the public hearing at 7:00 and asked the Clerk to read the notice. He asked three times if anyone wished to speak, introduced Robin Johnson for the Ontario County Real Property Tax Service to answer questions. Hearing no comments or questions the public hearing was closed. Councilman Hagen made the motion to adopt the Local Law #2-2009 “Abolishment of Elected Assessor”, seconded by Councilman Ferguson.

Adopted: Ayes – Champlin, Ferguson, Hagen, Rehberg Nays - None

Resolves that Local Law #2-2009 “Abolishment of Elected Assessor” is adopted.

Robin suggested the Board appoint the Assessor in January when the other appointments are made and advised the Board that the term will be January 1, 2010 to September 30, 2012 when the next term of six years would begin.

Supervisor Champlin will check with Attorney Anderson and Ontario County Human Resources to get the details on the appointment.

The Clerk will check with the Board of Elections to find out how to get the position of Assessor off of the November Ballot.

Old Business

Town Hall – Supervisor Champlin advised the Board that the Legion members will be voting on the sale of their property in September. Mr. Zonneville reported that he has shown the Town Hall four times and thanked the Board for the opportunity to list the property.

Changes to the Summer Rec. Program – Councilman Hagen asked if the Board should hire a professional program director to run the program. Supervisor Champlin said he knows Farmington and other towns use a professional and he can check with them.

New Business

Supervisor Champlin advised the Board that the State reporting requirements have changed effective August 12, 2009. The Clerk will get copies of the new legislation out to the Board for review.
